When logistics firm Peter Green Chilled took the decision to build a new cold storage facility for 3,000 pallets, site manager Malcolm Gold was keen to find a group of contractors which could mix technical expertise with great customer service.

We provided a range of coldstore technology for this project including panels, underfloor heater mats, floor insulation, pressure release valves and a range of specialist doors.

One unique element we helped implement was lighting. Due to ceiling height restrictions, we sourced panel recessed LED light fittings, incorporating a heated stem to stop cold bridging and increase thermal efficiency.

The benefits are already tangible. Once live, Malcolm reported that the fridge plant was operating at just 20% capacity at the desired negative temperature – an impressive insulation and vapour sealing performance.




How we delivered
